Submission of Entries:

Entries will only be accepted from the Provincial Coordinators – they will not be accepted from clubs. International entries will be eligible and considered for participation if received from Gymnastics Federations, State/Regions or on special invitation from GymSports NZ (for example High Performance Centres).

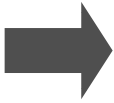

Welcome to Nelson

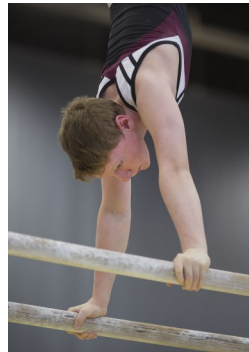
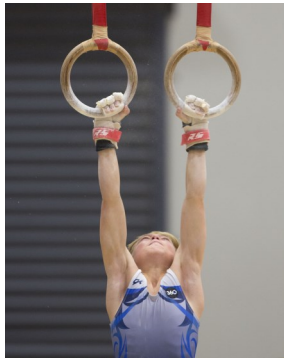
